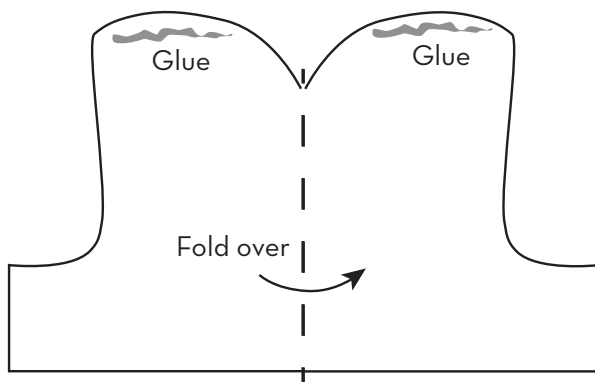
How to Make the Head:

What You Need:

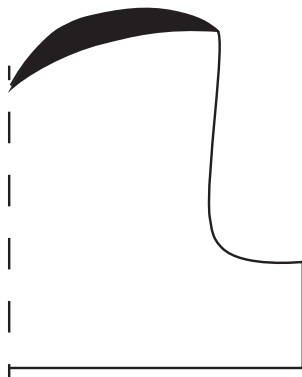
- large piece of white felt
- small piece of black felt
- orange card stock
- straight pins
- pencil
- glue
- markers

What You Do:

1. Cut out Puffin Head, Head Top pieces, and Beak. (See pages 2-3 for instructions.)
2. Open the head shape and apply glue to the inside at the top only. Fold over and press until glue is dry.



3. Glue a Head Top piece to either side of the head. Allow glue to dry.



4. Fold the orange beak in half and glue to the inside front of the head as shown, and allow to dry.



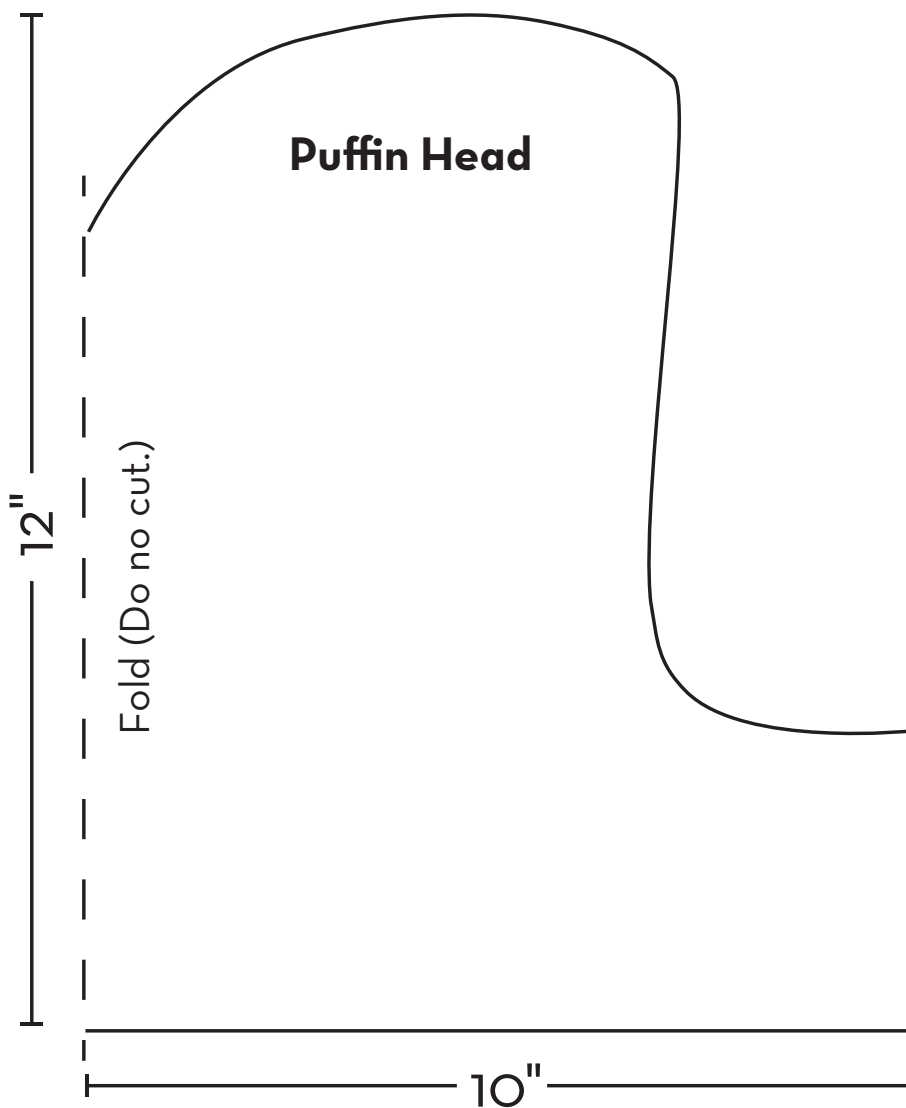
5. Use markers to draw the eyes, markings on the face, and beak





What You Do:

1. Measure and cut a 20" x 12" piece of white felt.
2. Fold in half so you have a 10" x 12" rectangle. Pin the sides together.
3. From the fold edge, draw the shape shown below on felt with a pencil. Cut around three sides.

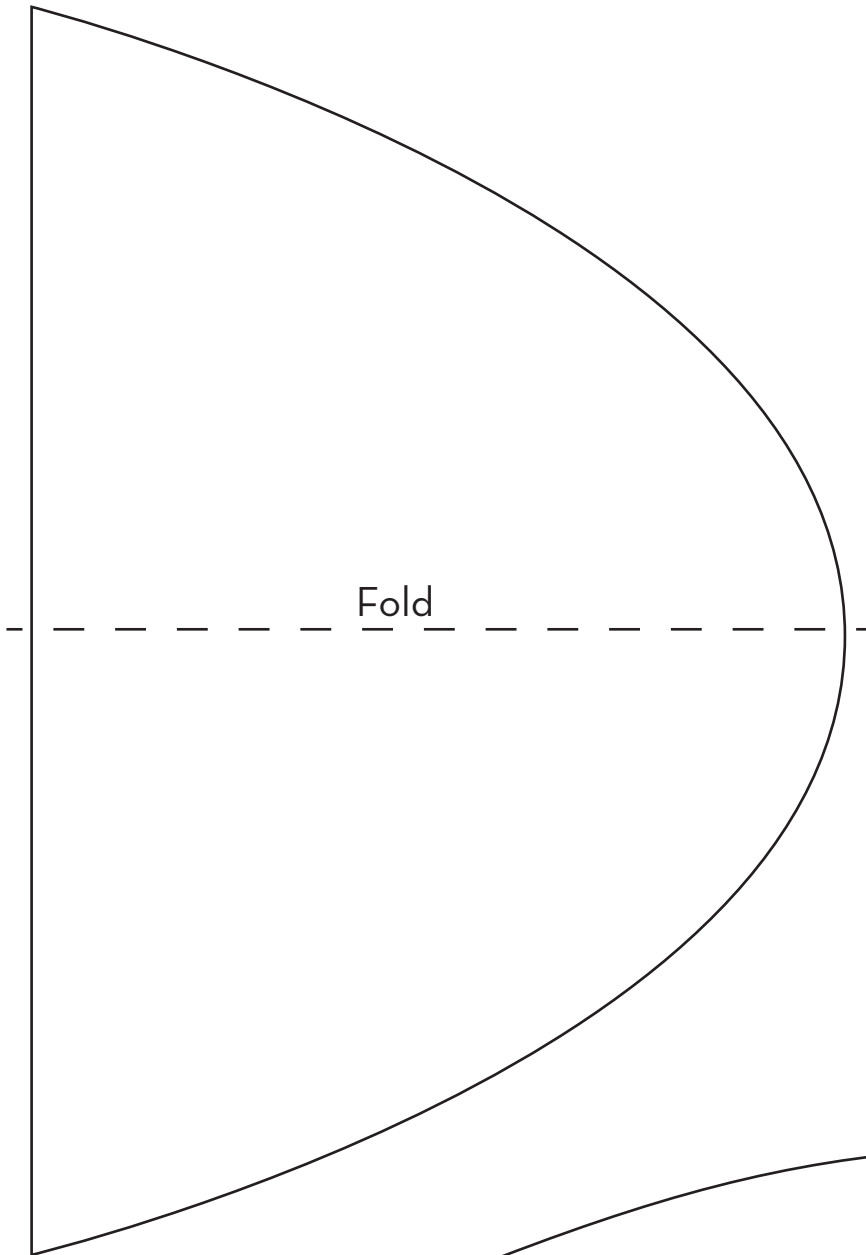




Beak (actual size)

What You Do:

1. Cut the beak piece out of orange card stock.



Head Top (actual size)

What You Do:

1. Cut 2 Head Tops out of black felt.





How to Make the Wings:

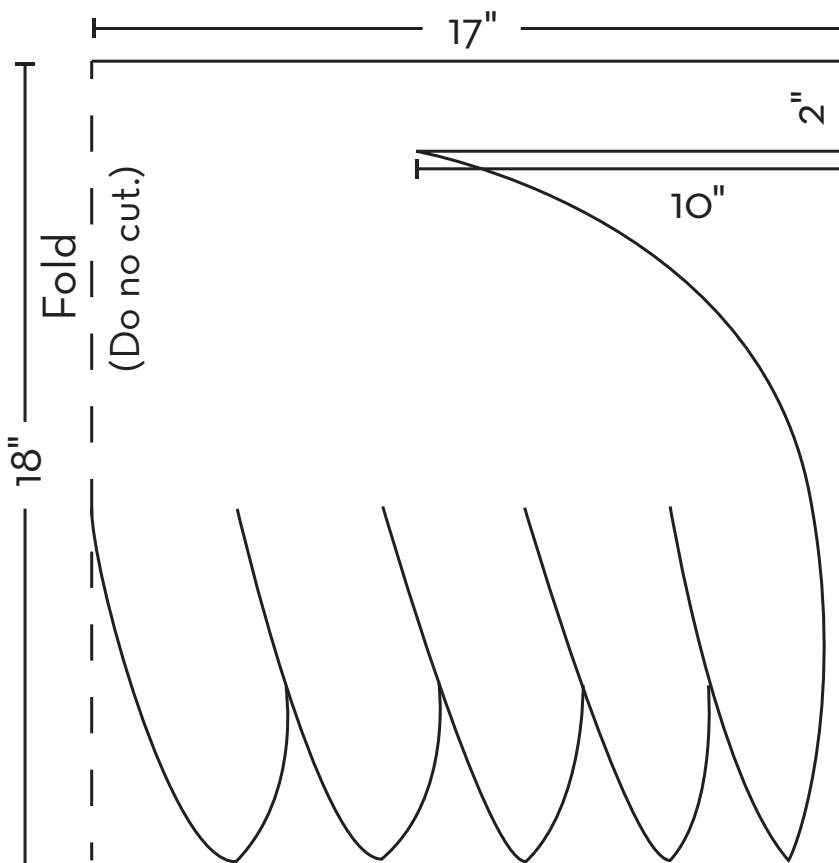
What You Need:

- large piece of black felt
- straight pins
- white chalk

What You Do:

1. Measure and cut a 34" x 18" rectangle out of black felt.
2. Fold in half and pin the two sides together.
3. From the fold edge, draw the shape shown below with chalk. Cut out all sides except the fold side.
4. Unfold and tie the straps around your neck to wear the wings.

NOTE: Use water to clear any lines left by the chalk.



How to Make the Feet:

What You Need:

- pair of orange flip flops
- orange card stock
- 2 orange pipe cleaners
- red and black markers

What You Do:

1. Cut two puffin feet out of orange card stock.
2. Punch two holes, as shown.
3. Color feet with markers, as shown.
4. Cut two 6" pieces of orange pipe cleaner. Thread each pipe cleaner through the holes on each foot. Use the pipe cleaner to attach each foot to a flip flop.
