Helpful Things to Take Along:

- ✓ Pencil or pen
- ✓ Camera, magnifying glass, and/or binoculars

CHOOSE A VIEW

- **Close Up**

Get down on the ground or right up next to something. If you want, use a magnifying glass.

- **From Afar**

Scan a whole scene from a long way away.

- **Zoomed In**

Use binoculars to get close to something in the distance.

- **Bird's Eye**

Climb up on something and look down.

- **Bug's Eye**

Lie down on your back and look up.

- **Big or Small**

Look at something that makes you feel extra large or very small.

- **Upside Down**

Hang by your knees to see what you can see.
