



## NWF's Trees for Wildlife Tree Bank Event Application



National Wildlife Federation has created a tree bank, which consists of trees that have been donated for planting by members and donors. Trees may be requested from the bank by schools, nonprofit organizations, youth groups, volunteers and affiliates of National Wildlife Federation for community planting or giveaway events.

Special Consideration: NWF will give special consideration for application submitted for the following situations:

- a) Natural Disaster impacted areas: Hurricanes, tornadoes, wildfires, droughts, floods or other impacts
- b) Applications from NWF focused metro areas of work: NYC (including NJ), Baltimore, Washington DC, Houston, Seattle, Atlanta, Chicago, and Los Angeles

### ***Important Notes:***

- Review tree bank guidelines prior to completing application.
- Application for spring planting must be received by January 31.
- Application must be received at least one month prior to the requested planting date for consideration.
- Applicants will be notified (of approval or denial) within 7-10 business days from the date application is received.
- Request will be fulfilled based on the number of trees available, number of students engaged, and nature of the events (impact and education opportunity).
