Dear Member of Congress:

On behalf of the undersigned organizations and the millions of Americans who hunt and fish, we are writing to express our strong opposition to Representative Pombo's provisions in the House budget reconciliation bill, H.R. 4241. Couched as revisions to modernize the General Mining Law, these provisions would hang a "For Sale" sign on millions of acres of our public lands. These lands provide crucial habitat for the game birds, deer, and elk our members hunt. They provide healthy watersheds and streams where our members fish. Moreover, these lands, so important to sportsmen and women, are open to every American, rich and poor alike. We believe it is wrong to put them up for mining companies and other commercial interests to buy at cut-rate prices.

It is even more outrageous to do this as part of a last-minute addition to a budget bill, without hearings or any other forum for the public to voice its concerns. Representative Pombo's promise that he will amend the bill again in conference to ensure hunting and fishing access to these lands rings hollow. There can be no guarantee of access to land once it is sold and such access would mean little once fish and wildlife habitat is carved up and paved over.

While we recognize that America faces fiscal challenges, we do not believe the budget can, or should, be balanced by selling off our public lands. Furthermore, the damaging provisions that remove land from the public trust cheat American taxpayers in order to offer a windfall to special interests. The bill disregards the value of the minerals associated with these lands and prohibits the government from charging royalties for the taxpayers who own these lands.

Our public lands are a sacred trust that pays dividends every year in equal access for hunting and angling and other outdoor recreation. A survey conducted by the United States Fish and Wildlife Service in 2001 concluded that fishing and hunting in the West contributes more than \$9 billion each year to local economies. More than 80% of the hunters surveyed by the Service in these states and 40% of hunters surveyed nationwide used public lands. By some estimates, Representative Pombo's provisions would raise only \$158 million over five years. To do this, it would liquidate millions of acres of public assets, prized by our members, their families and millions of other Americans.

Beginning with the establishment of the National Parks and Forests more than a century ago, Congress repeatedly has recognized the unique place public lands have played in our history and the democratic values they represent. For more than three decades it has been the express policy of this nation to retain these lands in public ownership and to manage them for the benefit of all Americans. We urge you to continue this legacy. Protect the exceptional opportunity the public lands provide to hunters and anglers throughout the country. Vote against the budget reconciliation bill.
